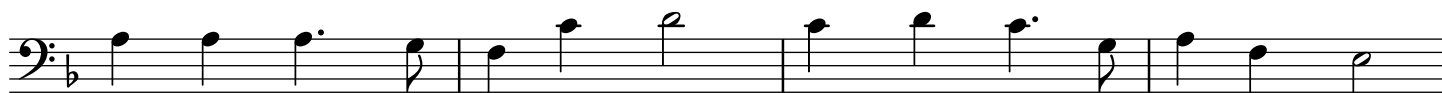

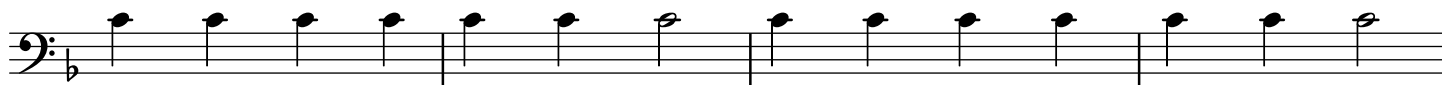

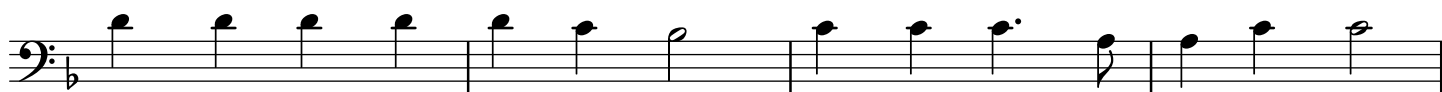
1. Hark! the her - ald an - gels sing, "Glo - ry to the new - born King;

Life and light to all He brings, Risen with heal - ing in His wings.

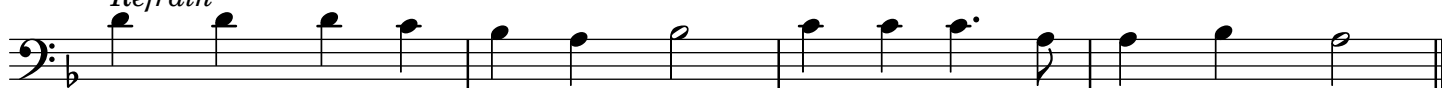


Joy - ful, all ye na - tions, rise, Join the tri - umph of the skies;
